It was terrific to have Archbishop Jeremy as the presider and preacher, and lovely that Professor Peter Sherlock could join us in his last few weeks as Vice-Chancellor of the University of Divinity. It was also an occasion when we acknowledged the contribution that Dr Sheilagh O'Brien has made to St Francis College, especially with our rapid transition to the University of Divinity.

Course advice is now being provided by our Academic Dean, the

Rev'd Dr Wendi Sargeant. I really appreciate the additional work undertaken by her and also Linda Burridge and Wendy Dann in the office during a very busy enrolment period. If you are interested in doing a piece of research such as a M.Phil. or PhD, please contact the Rev'd Dr Greg Jenks, our acting Research Coordinator, while Associate Professor Peter Kline is on sabbatical this semester.

The University of Divinity will hold a Graduation Ceremony in Brisbane for the first time this year. It will be on Pentecost Sunday May 19, 2024 as part of choral evensong at 6 pm in St John's Cathedral. It will be quite an occasion with the Deputy Chancellor coming from Melbourne and Archbishop Emeritus, Phillip Aspinall, as the guest speaker. The eight St Francis College students graduating will be joined by several students from other Colleges of the University.

For those of you who are graduates of St Francis College I encourage you to join the Alumni organisation. After a couple of years of hiatus, the AGM will be held at 3 pm on Friday June 21, 2024 at St Francis College. Please register interest here by 9am on that day to receive the agenda papers. Already this year, it is the end of the first teaching block for the University of Divinity, the Lay Education (FormEd Faith) team has visited three deaneries, the Ordination Formation program intensives have started, including a silent retreat focused on Benedictine spirituality, the Spiritual Direction Formation course has 4 new enrolments and AYCF have held a young adults retreat and quiz night.

For those of you who are graduates of St Francis College you are encouraged to join the SFC Alumni organisation.


After a couple of years of hiatus, their **AGM** will be held at 3 pm on Friday June 21, 2024 at St Francis College.

Time: 4.00pm - 6:00pm


Venue: Old Bishopsbourne at St Francis College, 233 Milton Rd, Milton.

An experienced parish priest, Joan blends her work in the church and desire to follow Christ's mission and calling with her academic learning. A New Testament scholar with a classics background, her research areas include the Letter to the Colossians, Greek inscriptions in Asia Minor, Greek and Roman religion, women in Asia Minor, and the cultural engagement between pagans, Jews and Christians.


